Mr. Feinberg made a Motion to appoint David Kunsman and Company to serve as Borough Auditor. Second by Mrs. Lilly-Kemmerer.

Mr. Feinberg made a Motion to appoint Mr. McGowan as the MECAB representative and Mr. Starniri as the Alternate MECAB representative. Second by Mrs. Lilly-Kemmerer.
