READING OF THE MINUTES:

Motion by Mr. Feinberg to approve the minutes from the October 10, 2016 Council meeting as presented. Second by Mr. Starniri. Council unanimously approved the minutes.

GUEST:

Mr. Donald Barrett of Wilson Borough Midget Football was present and brought along Ms. Louise Arciszewski of Adams Outdoor Advertising. Mr. Barrett is trying to place a scoreboard at Fisk field and has been speaking with Adams to do so. In return Adams would like the right to place a billboard along Route 22 at Fisk Field at some future date. Solicitor Margle said the Borough cannot enter into a private contract for this. An RFP would need to be advertised to give others a chance to bid. The RFP must be very specific and will include the scoreboard. Motion by Mr. Feinberg to have Mr. Margle draft a Request for Proposals for the scoreboard and billboard. Second by Mr. Starniri. Council concurred.

Mr. Margle advised Council that the draft amendment to Ordinance #537 as it relates to for profit as opposed to nonprofit entities has been presented to Council and is ready for advertising.
